

# What GS MAINS CARSH COURSE is all about?

This is a complete value addition program for GS Mains 2025. It will cover last two years contemporary issues and key topics of GS Mains Paper I, II, III & IV. Apart from the key topics that are directly mentioned in the UPSC syllabus, many sub-topics that lies in the periphery of such topics will also be covered in this program.
