# FAQs



## What GS MAINS CARSH COURSE is all about?

This is a complete value addition program for GS Mains 2025. It will cover last two years contemporary issues and key topics of GS Mains Paper I, II, III & IV. Classes will be conducted 6 days a week (Monday to Saturday) each of 4 hours.



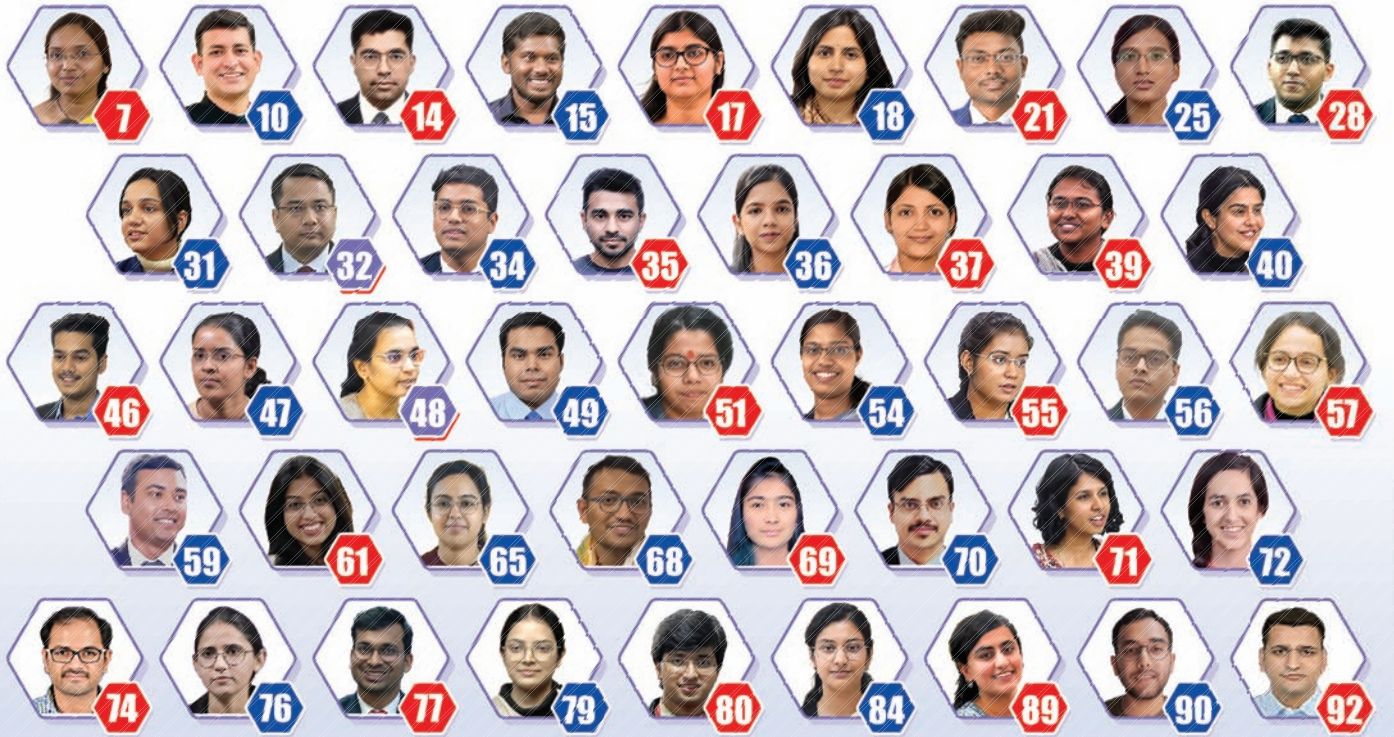

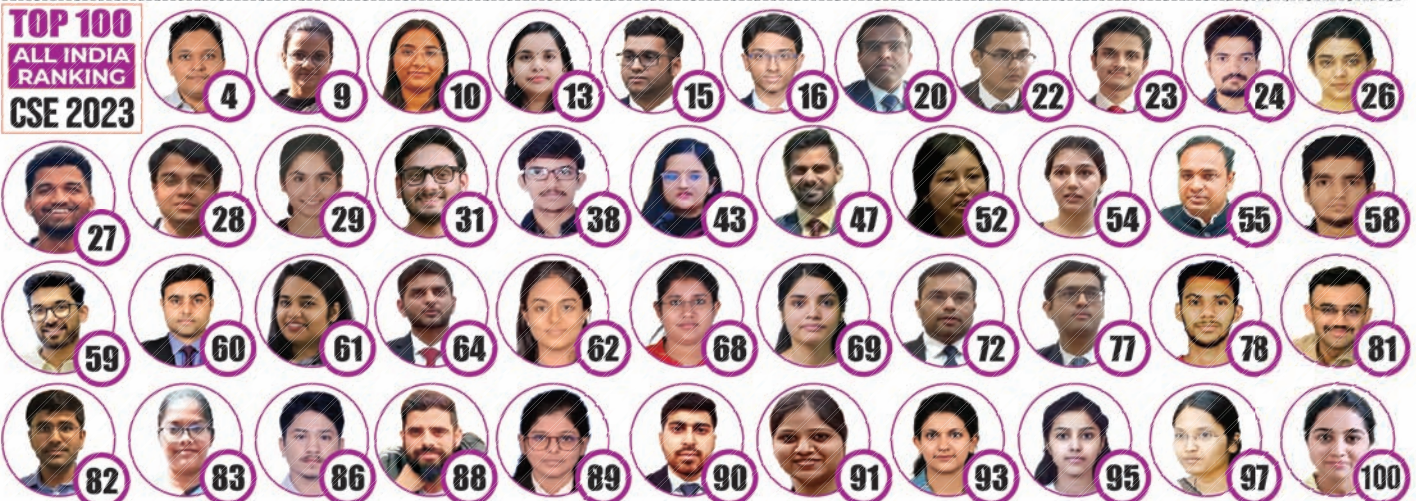
### TOP 100 ALL INDIA RANKING UPSC-CSE 2024
