

03	The login window for online students to access the test will be from 7:30 AM to 8:30 AM.
04	GS Mains Tests will consist of 5 questions and test timing will be 7:30 AM to 8:20 AM (50 min). Students who opted for online mode will have to submit their copy by 4:00 PM of the test date.
05	GS Mains Weekly Revision Tests will consist of 10 Questions. The Test timing will be 9:00 AM to 10:40 AM.
06	Evaluation of topical test mains copy will be done within 3 working days or before the mentorship session for that test.
07	Evaluation of Weekly Revision Mains Tests will be done within 7 days.
