

DIFFERENCE

ORDINARY BILL

- It can be introduced either in LS & not in RS
- It can be introduced either by a member or by private member
- It can be introduced without the recommendation of President
- It can be amended or Rejected by RS
- It can be detained by RS For maximum period OF 6 month
- It does not requires certification of Speaker when transmitted to RS (if it has originated in LS)
- Sent For President's assent due to disagreement between the 2 houses & hence a joint of both houses can be summoned by the president to resolve the deadlock
- Its defeat in LS leads to the resignation of Govt of it is introduced by minister
- It can be rejected or approved or returned for reconsideration by President

MONEY BILL

- It can be introduced only in LS & not in RS
- It can be introduced only by a minister
- It can be introduced only on the recommendation of President
- It cannot be amended or Rejected by RS The bill with or without recommendations, which may be accepted or rejected by the LS
- It can be detained by RS For maximum period OF 14 days
- It requires certification of Speaker when transmitted to RS
- Sent For President's assent even if it is approved by only LS
There is no chance of any disagreement between the 2 houses & hence, there is no provision of joint sitting of both, Houses in this regard
- Its defeat in LS leads to resignation of Govt
- It can be rejected or approved but cannot be returned Far reconsideration by the President
