- C. Power is directed From Constitution**
- D. We can amend & make new constitutional bodies as well**
 - 1. Art. 368 cor Amendment

NON-CONSTITUTIONAL BODIES

- A. Any body either created through law by legislature or through executive resolution**
- B. Both bodies can be made by both Center + state**
 - I. Statutory Body (a) Enacted by statute (b) Bodies)
 - i. Lokpal (centre) ii. Lokayukts (state)
 - c. Law called Regulation**
 - d. For e.g.**
 - I. National Green Tribunal which given direction hence known as Regulation
- C. By Executive**
- D. By Executive Resolution**
 - 1. E.g. (a. Planning Commission)
 - i. Now NITI Aayog
 - 2. Not kept in Constitution
 - a. Reason** (i. To change any moment in need)
