

How classes will be conducted?

Our IAS Foundation Course includes complete syllabus coverage of Prelims cum Mains, Current Affairs and Test Series. Duration of the course will be from the starting date of the batch till Mains Exam. Classes are divided into following three parts:

- Complete syllabus will be covered in approximately 10 Months. We cover one subject at one time or two subjects simultaneously with holistic coverage of Mains and Prelims part of syllabus.
- Separate Prelims Revision Class will be conducted through our specialized course i.e. "Target PT Revision Classes" in which focus is to revise the whole syllabus effectively from Prelims point of view (GS and Current Affairs).
- After Prelims there will be 150 hrs. Mains updation classes where focus is to cover and revise GS Paper 1,2,3 and 4 as well as essay followed by mock test.

How Current Affairs are covered?

Current affairs are covered along with the regular classes by interlinking dynamic and static parts. We cover all the contemporary issues for both prelims and mains. Revision of current affairs will be done before prelims and after prelims for main examination.

What will be the schedule of the tests?

Tests will be conducted into two layers i.e. class test and All India Mock Test for Prelims and Main Examination. During regular classes tests will be conducted according to the Session Plan.

For Preliminary Examination Tests are divided as:

- Sub-sectional Tests based on single Topics
- Sectional Tests based on each subject
- CSAT Tests
- Mock Tests (Full length)



How answer writing will be covered in the course?

Answer Writing plays an important role in the Mains examination. The conceptual base for Mains examination will be laid through the exhaustive classes covering both theoretical as well as contemporary part of the syllabus.

Content + Good Writing Skill = Good Marks

Thus, to develop it Main Examination Tests will be conducted as follows:

- Topic based Tests after completion of Topics (5-10 questions).
- Subject Based Tests (20 Questions each).

Details about All India GS Mains Test Series

Once the content is known through Comprehensive Classes, for the articulation of that knowledge at RIGHT PLACE and in RIGHT FORMAT, the programme will cover the Mains Test Series. It will consist of 31 Tests:

- 18 Sectional Tests 20 Questions each.
- 8 Mock Tests (full length) UPSC Pattern
- 5 Contemporary issues-based Tests

Tests include Discussion, Copy Evaluation and Personalized Doubt Clearing Session.

How study materials will be provided?

4 levels of study materials will be provided.

- Basic Syllabus
- Currents Issues related to every section of Syllabus
- Weekly Current Affairs Study Materials
- Answer Writing Practice Workbook for each Session.

Is there any sort of Revision Classes as well?

Yes, once we cover the complete syllabus there will be Prelims Revision Course just before Preliminary Examination and for the Main Examination there will be approx. 150 hours Updation Classes.







Procedure for ONLINE CLASSES

ONLINE CLASSES

- To enroll student has to register on the website using Registration Form or Google Login or Facebook Login.
- If already registerd login with your username and password which you have used for registration.
- Account for Online Classes will be activated within one working day of Enrollment or before batch Starts.
- Classes will be conducted online as per the class schedule.
- Weekly Class Schedule will be uploaded into students account with session plan and doubt clearing sessions schedule.
- Study Material is into two formats i.e. printed and pdf.
- Printed Study Material, if any will be dispatched by courier within a week of enrollment.
- Soft Copy notes will be uploaded in PDF format into your account.

DOUBT CLEARING

- Separate doubt clearing sessions will be conducted via Google Meet
- Once class is over, it will be uploaded into the Student's Account and can be accessed anytime till Mains Examination of 2021.
- Students who access the classes after a live session can clear their doubts through a chat box or in the next session.

MAINS TEST SERIES

- Tests will be uploaded in PDF format in your account.
- To write the test students have to download the PDF of test paper booklet or write the test in A4 sheet with proper spacing as per UPSC pattern. After writing the test send us back scanned copy in pdf format for evaluation.
- Further evaluated test copy will be sent back to the students within 15 days after receiving the answer sheet.
- Test discussion video will be uploaded into your account on the scheduled test date.
- Once student will receive evaluated copy, one to one discussion with concerned faculty/experts will be arranged via phone call or live interaction.

PRELIMS TEST SERIES

- Test schedule will be given in advance. Test will be activated on the scheduled date.
- Once a test is activated you can write it as per your suitable time (Flexible Test Timings).
- Tests will be submitted once you click the submit button or it crosses the time limit.
- After submission of the test you will get your score and All India Ranking.
- Detailed model answers will be provided.
- Your score and performance chart will be available in your "My Account" section for future access.
