- It was launched to crowd-source innovative toys and games ideas.
- It was a joint initiative by the Ministry of Education, WCD (Women and Child Development) Ministry, Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Textile Ministry, Ministry of

Information and Broadcasting and All India Council for Technical Education.



- It aims to promote India as a global toy manufacturing hub under Atmanirbhar Bharat.
- It conceptualize innovative toys based on the Indian value system which will inculcate positive behaviour and good value among the children.

- Based on: Indian culture and ethos, local folklore and heroes, and Indian value systems.
- Themes: Nine themes, including fitness and sport and rediscovering traditional Indian toys.
- Participants: Students, teachers, start-ups and toy experts.
- Prize: Participants can get prizes upto Rs. 50 lakhs
