What is the World Happiness Report?

The World Happiness Report

ranks 149 countries by how happy their citizens perceive themselves to be.

 It is different from the Human Development Report (HDR) which focuses on three dimensions – healthy life, knowledge and standard of living.

Findings

- Unemployment during the pandemic is associated with a 12% decline in life satisfaction and a 9% increase in negative effect.
- The rankings are based onpolling (Gallup World Poll) which looks at six variables:

Gross Domestic Product Per Capita (Purchasing Power Parity).

Healthy life expectancy at birth

Freedom to make life choices

Social

Support

Generosity

Perceptions of corruption

 Respondents are asked to rate their own current lives on a 0-10 scale.

Top Performers

- Finland has been ranked as the happiest country in the world for the fourth consecutive year.
- Followed by Iceland, Denmark, Switzerland, The Netherlands, Sweden, Germany and Norway.

Worst Performers

- Afghanistan (149) is the unhappy country.
- Followed by Zimbabwe (148), Rwanda (147), Botswana (146) and Lesotho (145).

India

- India has been ranked 139, out of 149 countries evaluated.
- In 2020, India was ranked 144 out of 156 countries surveyed.
