When you raised the concern, she replied that this is matter of few weeks only, and also saying no will bring them on street. As in such a metro city one cannot survive without work, everything has a cost. You are Mayor of the city.



Due to the contemporary developments in the information technology and convergence, Q3. the access of adults and children to media including variety of entertainment have increased.
