- 5. "The central question of normative ethics is determining how basic moral standards are arrived at and justified, and the answers to this question fall into two broad categories, deontological and teleological". In the light of the above statement, differentiate between the two.
- 6. Explain and elaborate the following statements:
 - (a) The best way to find yourself is to lose yourself in the service of others.
 - (b) Happiness is when what you think, what you say, and what you do are in harmony.
- 7. "Freedom of the press is not just important to democracy, it is democracy". Discuss how the post-truth is a threat to this idea?
- 8. The study of ethics can deepen our reflection on the ultimate questions of life. The study of ethics helps a person to look at his own life critically and to evaluate his actions. In the light of the above statement, examine the importance of ethics in our lives. Also evaluate where ethics are leading us to in modern times?
- 9. Explain 'Corporate Accountability'. Is it justifiable that the government should take various initiatives to bring Corporate Accountability?
- 10. On one hand, religion is a source of ethics and morality for the followers; and on the other hand, people inflict violence on others in the name of religion. Does it raise the question of the morality of worshipers? How?
- 11. Child labor is still a common thing in our society despite having stringent laws against child labor. What drives its prevalence?
- 12. Medical tourism is a method of availing medical facilities in another country. But at a time when medical ethics are already threatened by illegal medical practices, then what can be done to ensure the safety of medical tourists in host countries?

What you could make out is that her two married sons have disowned her and are not allowing her to enter into their house. The lady had approached the local revenue officials and also elected representatives of PRIs but without any result. She neither has money nor any support system to rely upon.
 - (a) What are the options available to you?
 - (b) Examine the merits/demerits of each option and suggest the best option with reasons.
- 14. You are a middle rank land revenue officer posted in a rural area. There is a river which has to be crossed to go to the other side. Your jurisdiction also is on the other side of the river. Every year settlement of ferry services are made and the highest bidder arranges the local boats on which people cross the river. The rate of ferry services is fixed by you. Unfortunately, this year, during Monsoon, one of the boats capsized in the river which resulted in the drowning of 10 people. You have been warned by higher authorities that you should take safety measures, otherwise face the consequences. You have decided to act strictly. Following are some of the options. Examine the various options with their merits and demerits and finally suggest the best course of action with justifications.
 - (a) Put a sign board on the bank of the river warning the people of using ferry services, at their own risk.
 - (b) Request the district police chief to depute sufficient police for ensuring safety of the people.
 - (c) Ask the person who has taken the annual settlement to ensure the safety of people.
 - (d) Depute a field level revenue official for ensuring safety, who should be always available on the river bank.
